Decorate an Egg

How to blow out an uncooked egg to decorate.

These are easy follow but you will need to work together on this with a grown-up or older brother or sister until you are sure you know what you are doing.

Care is needed as eggs and shells are delicate.

This blown egg can be decorated carefully with felt tips or paints or with coloured tissue and glue. Stand it in an egg cup whilst you are working on it or once it is finished. You could design your egg pattern using the sheet over the page.

You may also wish to make you own stand out of half a toilet roll tube.



Food is precious so don't waste the insides. Look below for ideas to cook the inside of your eggs.

100 ways to cook an egg

Look at all the pictures. Take your time as there are many ways to cook an egg here. Is your favorited type of cooked egg here?

Choose five that look good to eat to you. Now look closely at each one. Which one recipe would you like to cook and tell your Mum or Dad why you like it.
